



## Duty to Consult on Felling Street Trees

This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be removed. From the date of this notice there is a 28 day period in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the duty to consult requirements set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021

<b>Site</b>	Rokeby Gardens
<b>Position</b>	OS 18
<b>Species</b>	Tamarix aestivalis (Tamarix)
<b>Reason for removal</b>	Originally planted as a trial of a new species. Now considered to be an inappropriate species due to habit and shape.
<b>Solutions considered</b>	Pruning is not considered a suitable solution, due to the tree's speed of growth and it is not considered appropriate for the landscape
<b>Replacement</b>	A single replacement tree, suitable for this position, is programmed to be planted between November 2024 and March 2025
