

## **CORRECT PRESENTATION OF WASTE**

Please ensure all of your rubbish is securely contained, in your Council provided wheelie bin, with the lid fully closed by 6am on your collection day.

Failure to comply with this request may result in enforcement action.

Always present your bin at the boundary



Do not obstruct the highway with your bin



Do not leave bags next to your wheelie bin



Do not present your bin without the lid being fully shut



## Waste do's and don'ts

So that your waste can be collected, please follow the following guidelines.

**Do:** Present your waste in the wheelie bin provided by Redbridge Council.

**Do:** Only place grass cuttings, hedge trimmings, pruning's and small branches, weeds, leaves and dead plants in your garden waste sack.

**Do:** Place your wheelie bin, recycling boxes or garden waste sack for collection on the boundary of your property. DO NOT PLACE BAGS OR WASTE ON THE PAVEMENT

**Don't:** Obstruct the pavement with wheelie bins, recycling boxes, or garden waste sacks. It is an offence under the Environmental Protection Act and Highways Act.

**Don't:** Put any hot ashes, asbestos, stones, building materials, heavy items, chemicals, corrosive liquids or any other substances which are hazardous to health in your wheelie bin.

**Don't:** Present any general waste unless it is fully contained in your council wheelie bin. SIDE WASTE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.

**Don't:** Put your garden waste out on the same day as your household and recycling waste, as it is NOT collected on the same day.
