

Notice of Polling Districts and Polling Places Review 2024

In accordance with the requirements of section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983, notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Redbridge is undertaking a review of polling districts and polling places used in connection with parliamentary elections held within the Borough.

Information about the review process and details of the existing polling districts and polling places are available for inspection on the council's website at [Redbridge - Polling district and polling places review](#), at the Electoral Services Office at the address shown below between the hours of 9.00am and 5.00pm, Monday to Friday or in libraries throughout the Borough.

Registered electors within the London Borough of Redbridge and other interested parties including all local residents, community groups and organisations are invited to make representations in writing to the Electoral Registration Officer.

We would welcome representations from any persons with particular expertise in relation to accessibility issues regarding premises or facilities for persons with different forms of disability.

Representations should, where appropriate, include suggestions for alternative venues that may be used as polling places.

The consultation period has been extended to 8 weeks due to the summer holiday period.
