LONDON LOCAL AUTHORITIES ACT 1991 PART II THE LONDON BOROUGH OF REDBRIDGE REQUIRES PREMISES REGISTERED FOR SPECIAL TREATMENTS TO COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING

PIERCING

No person under the age of 18 may receive body piercing of any kind.

Persons aged 16-18 years of age may, with written permission of a parent of guardian have:

- υ piercing of the eyebrow to include outer zone only;
- υ piercing of the septum excluding the cartilage and using a canular only;
- υ piercing of the navel.

All customers are reminded that secondary infection can occur if piercings are not kept scrupulously clean.

There are further risks associated with some piercings.

Ensure, before any treatment, that you have discussed fully with your piercer the area you wish to have pierced and that you have received written aftercare instructions before you leave the premises.
