# London Borough of Redbridge (Fouling of Land by Dogs) Order 2010

The London Borough of Redbridge hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order comes in to force on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2010.
- 2. This Order applies to the land specified in the Schedule.

#### 3. Offence

- (1) If a dog defecates at any time on land to which this Order applies and a person who is in charge of the dog at that time fails to remove the faeces from the land forthwith, that person shall be guilty of an offence, unless -
  - (a) he has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so; or
  - (b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land, has consented (generally or specifically) to his failing to do so.
- (2) Nothing in this article applies to a person who
  - (a) is registered as a blind person in a register compiled under section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948;
     or
  - (b) has a disability which affects his mobility, manual dexterity, physical co-ordination or ability to lift, carry or otherwise move everyday objects, in respect of a dog trained by a prescribed charity and upon which he relies for assistance.
- (3) For the purposes of this article
  - (a) a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog;
  - (b) placing the faeces in a receptacle on the land which is provided for the purpose, or for the disposal of waste, shall be a sufficient removal from the land:

- (c) being unaware of the defecation (whether by reason of not being in the vicinity or otherwise), or not having a device for, or other suitable means of removing the faeces shall not be a reasonable excuse for failing to remove the faeces;
- (d) each of the following organisations is a "prescribed charity" for the purposes of Article (2)(b) above
  - (i) Dogs for the Disabled (Registered Charity Number 700454)
  - (ii) Support Dogs (Registered Charity Number 1088281)
  - (iii) Canine Partners for Independence (Registered Charity Number 803680).

# 4. Penalty

A person who is guilty of an offence contrary to Article 3 of this Order shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Redbridge (Fouling of Land by Dogs) Order 2010, and came into force on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2010.

### **SCHEDULE**

Any land which is open to the air and to which the public have access (with or without payment) within the London Borough of Redbridge
