## Duty to Consult on Felling Street Trees

This is a notification that this tree is proposed to be removed. From the date of this notice there is a 28 day period in which you can provide comments on the proposed tree removal. This notice meets the duty to consult requirements set out in section 115 of the Environment Act 2021

<b>Reason for removal</b>	Highway development road safety scheme.

**Solutions considered** Tree removal is required to install a new Zebra crossing. Alternative locations for the crossing have been discounted as they are deemed to be inappropriate.

**Replacement** Tree will not be replaced due to the installation of a zebra crossing. A new position has been identified in the same street to have a replacement tree planted.
