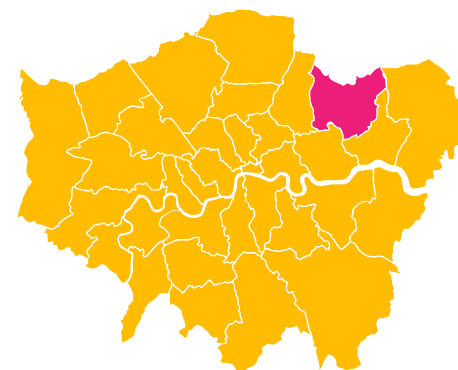


How we're making our area a cleaner, greener, healthier and safer place

We continue to be short changed by government funding compared to other boroughs, the stark reality is that the average government funding per head in Redbridge is **£751** compared to the London average of **£879**, if we received fair funding, we could provide an extra **£39m** worth of council services.

We've responded to the challenge of government cuts by becoming a more efficient council, making **£224m** of efficiency savings, transforming the way we work and generating more money to protect the brilliant services local people care about.
