It comprises an internal seating area for up to 28 patrons and a small outdoor terrace at the front with 5 tables, which is under the control of the licence holder and supervised by staff. The premises currently operates with a bar and dining area, with kitchen and staff facilities located to the rear. Alcohol is served for consumption on the premises as part of the restaurant service, and also available for off-sales in sealed containers. Off-sales may be consumed on the terrace, which is covered by the premises CCTV system and appropriate signage requesting customers to respect neighbouring residents. The licence holder seeks to vary the licence as follows: Extension of opening hours - Proposed opening hours: 07:00 to 23:00 daily Addition of regulated entertainment - Occasional provision of live music (e.g. classical and pop) during operational hours Amendment to conditions - Removal of the condition requiring alcohol to be served only with a main meal - This would allow patrons to consume alcohol without the requirement to order food, in line with the premises character as a restaurant offering flexible service Representation may be made by any other persons online	MORE ITALY LTD
