

SALARY BANDINGS FOR THE 2014 LOCAL GOVERNMENT PENSION SCHEME

Notification of the salary bands to apply from 1 April 2026

If you are a member of the Local Government Pension Scheme, you will be aware that the contribution you pay will depend on the pay band you fall into.

These pay bands are reviewed each April, and this years increase is 3.8% on last years

Please note that you will pay contributions on **all pay received**. If you work part time, your % rate will be based on the actual pay you earn for your job. Your band may change if you experience a significant and permanent change to your salary.

The pension contribution bands are as follows:

Band Range	Contribution Rate Main section	Contribution Rate 50/50 section
Actual pensionable pay	Gross % rate	Gross % rate
£0 - £18,400	5.50%	2.75%
£18,401 - £29,000	5.80%	2.90%
£29,001 - £47,300	6.50%	3.25%
£47,301 - £59,800	6.80%	3.4%
£59,801 - £84,000	8.50%	4.25%
£84,001 - £119,100	9.90%	4.95%
£119,101 - £140,400	10.50%	5.25%
£140,401 - £210,700	11.40%	5.70%
£210,701 or more	12.50%	6.25%

Right of Appeal

Every time a decision is made regarding your pension benefits, including the salary band contribution you are paying, you have the right of appeal under the Internal Dispute Resolution Procedure (IDRP) regulations if you believe a wrong decision has been made. A copy of a leaflet regarding the IDRP can be obtained from the Pension office. However, if you feel that you are paying pension contributions on the wrong salary banding, you may wish to speak to your employer's payroll section first.
